The selection "Published lists" on the *top menu* provides access to all the published lists of the website.

The published lists are the partonomic lists of a whole chapter, frozen at some point in time.

This mechanism allows to store the memory of the site, after a substantial validation has been performed. It is like a publication of the terminology, stamped by its date of realization.

The selection "Partonomic Lists" on the *top menu* provides access to all the partonomic lists and sublists. A direct access is possible to the top level lists of each chapter and an indirect access to all other lists is given through the interlist navigation. The whole terminology is accessible by the partonomic lists. The partonomic lists are always presented in two languages, usually Latin and a modern language. The language selection is set in advance and remains permanent, but can be changed at any moment.

The selection "Taxonomic Lists" on the *top menu* provides access to all the taxonomic lists and sublists. The whole terminology is accessible by the taxonomic lists. The taxonomy is subdivided into 13 main branches at level T1. Each T1 branch is subdivided in a number of branches at level 2. The same process leads to levels 3 and 4. Not all levels are necessarily present for each main branch. The taxonomic lists are always presented in two languages, usually Latin and a modern language. The language selection is set in advance and remains permanent, but can be changed at any moment.
